The individual must be:

1. A primary member of PCMCU in good standing\*
2. Beginning or continuing their post-secondary education as a full-time student this fall 2020
3. Willing to provide a response to this essay topic:

***Share with us a dream you hold, that when you look back at your life in thirty years you would consider your life successful? What people, resources, and accomplishments do you feel you need to make that dream come true?***

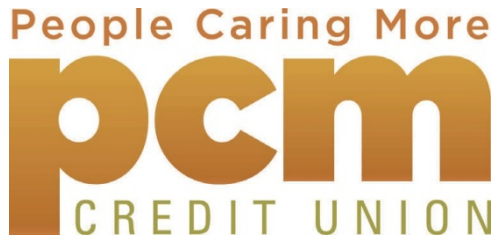
To qualify, applications must be postmarked or received at PCMCU by **Friday, March 6, 2020**. Winners will be contacted by **Monday, April 6, 2020**. Each application must be filled out completely to qualify.

We ask that each winner agree to allow PCMCU to use his/her name and photo in our promotional materials, such as the member newsletter, website, and social media channels.

Winners will be decided by a select group of PCMCU representatives who will read and/or view the essay submissions to determine which applicants are most deserving of the three scholarships.
