Make it a scam-free vacation

... with PCMCU's summer vacation reminders



Do some research – and then carefully read the details on travel offers.

First, get recommendations from family and friends on good travel agencies, vacation rentals, hotels, and travel packages – before responding to offers.

Look up travel companies, hotels, rentals, and agents with the words "scam," "review," or "complaint."

Look for extra costs. Resort fees (also known as destination, facility and amenity fees) can add \$50 or more to your nightly

Ask about taxes, which may be significant in many locations. **Get a copy of the cancellation and refund policies** before you pay. If you're buying travel insurance, be sure the agency is

Bring copies of any confirmation details that show the rate and amenities you were promised. This also helps if the hotel or host says your reservation is "lost."

Don't pay for "prize" vacations. No legitimate company will ask you to pay for a prize. Also, look for catches to resort or timeshare offers. They may come with taxes and fees to pay, timeshare presentations to attend, and high-pressure sales pitches to endure.

Don't sign anything until you know the terms of the deal. Say "no thanks" to anyone who tries to rush you, without giving you time to consider the offer.

Use a credit card, if possible, for your travel spending. This gives you more protection than paying by cash or debit card – and it may be easier to dispute unauthorized charges.

Protect your identity and account information while you're traveling. Take only the IDs, credit cards and debit cards you need. Make copies so, if someone steals your bag, you'll know exactly what was lost.

Make a copy of your insurance card to take with you. Leave all other important documents safe at home.

Learn how to protect your mobile devices and personal **information** from hackers and malware. And while we hope it doesn't happen to you, report identity theft and any other fraud you experience.

Instant Issue... Your Replacement Card in *Minutes*!

EMV chip cards! If you need a replacement card, your card is lost or stolen or you have a new account, we can place a card in your hand within minutes! This service is offered at both the Green Bay Main Office and Marinette Branch.

FRAUD ALER

PCM IS MONITORING SCAMS - HERE ARE SOME IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

Do not fall for a computer hacking scam where fraudsters tell victims they owe money for their firewall protection **DO NOT LET ANYONE INTO YOUR** COMPUTER.

There is an IRS scam where fraudsters threaten jail time if victims don't comply with the demands. HANG UP.

There is also a Social Security Number phone scam going on. Robocallers state you have to call a number to release your SSN from being revoked and penalized. DO NOT ANSWER ROBOCALLS.

Please call our fraud experts or stop in today. Fraud is not our friend!!

Call PCMCU with your travel plans

Call the credit union anytime you plan to travel to minimize any potential issues with PCMCU debit and credit cards. International travel is especially important as we have a vast majority of international countries blocked. Call us at 920-499-2831 and just say you would like to submit a travel notification.

Don't depend on one form of payment when traveling out of the area. Be prepared! Anything can happen while traveling, including losing cards or suspicious activity alerted by our fraud detection service. Please be sure to have a backup payment source with you just in case you experience any issues making international purchases. Online transactions may process internationally and could be declined. We recommend calling us if you experience this issue as we may need to unblock the country the transaction is processing through.

If you receive a phone call or text from our DEBIT CARD Fraud Detection Service, please note that you are only verifying if a transaction was initiated by you. Acknowledging that you initiated a transaction does not mean that the transaction will go through, even if you attempt to reprocess the transaction after confirming that it is **not fraud.** For denied transaction assistance, please contact the credit union and we will be happy to assist you!

If you receive a phone call from our automated CREDIT CARD Fraud Detection Service, please verify if the transaction in question was initiated by you. If the transaction is legitimate, they can make adjustments for the transaction to be authorized. Please do not ignore this phone call, your card will be restricted until you respond to our Credit Card Fraud Detection Service. If the transaction is fraudulent, they will assist you in completing any necessary disputes.

It is suggested you store these numbers into your phone so they can be easily recognized when they are received.
