If you are under the age of 18 we ask that you please contact PCM's Member Services in Green Bay (920) 593-2200 or Member Services in Marinette at (715) 732-4051 to set up your account, as a parent or guardian is required.

• Open a new PCMCU No Fee Checking account with \$50 opening deposit.

• Obtain an instant issue Mastercard Debit Card. Simply contact the credit union to request your new card. We recommend once you receive your new PCM debit card, you enroll in CardValet to protect your card usage.

• Enroll in PCMCU Free eServices. Click the 'Online Banking' button on our homepage to begin enrolling in Virtual Branch. Once you are enrolled in VB, you may download the Mobile App on your smart device.

Enroll in eStatements to receive your email notification when your statement is ready to view. Do this by logging into Virtual Branch, selecting the Self Service tab and clicking on eStatements under the Additional Services section.

*One time bonus deposit of \$100 will be deposited to the new regular savings account at the end of the month in which you open the membership. Smart Start program offer is available on all new member accounts, age 16-24. Certain restrictions apply. This bonus is considered other income and may be reported on IRS form 1099-misc. Online Sales are Up, but so is FRAUD

Safety Warning! PCM knows COVID-19 has changed life for all of us, including our shopping habits. We would like to share with you some safe online shopping tips to help protect you from fraud. Please take a moment to review these tips and remember... NEVER share your passwords or PINs!

Raised prices/Rock Bottom Prices

Too good to be true? Research the retailer to make sure they have good reviews, verify the contact information and make sure the website is secure by looking for 'https' at the start of the web address and the small closed padlock icon in the address bar.

Delays in delivery time/International Transactions

Due to COVID-19 your deliveries may be delayed. Know your rights in case the retailer cannot deliver within the agreed time frame. For your protection PCM has all international transactions blocked for debit and credit. A declined transaction may indicate that the transaction is international. We strongly encourage all card users to download our free CardValet App to assist you in monitoring the activity up to date. on your cards. Please refer to www.pcmcu.org, select Services and Card Security for CardValet details, or feel free to reach out to us anytime.

Ads on social media sites

A legitimate merchant will take great care of their online presentation. Watch for bad grammar or poor web design. After searching for an item online, you may notice it suddenly appear in your Facebook feed. Be leery of these ads as they are tracked through the cookies on your device

Counterfeit Goods

A good rule of thumb is "If it's too good to be true", it usually is. Anyone can copy a picture off of any website and send you a cheaper version or nothing at all after you have already paid them. Research the reviews of the seller and the product outside of their website to validate the seller or item. Don't only focus on the positive, also pay attention to the negative feedback. Shop where you trust, use merchants you are familiar with or have used in the past.

General Online Shopping Tips

 Review return and cancellation policies, READ THE FINE PRINT before ordering. Free trial offers usually result in further charges.

When making purchases, keep your order details.

• Don't provide more information than what is needed. Merchants should only be requesting name, billing and shipping information along with payment details.

• Disregard overly aggressive pop-ups or push notifications.

• Public WI-FI is unprotected so be careful not to make purchases or log in to secure sites while on a public network.

• Check the copyright if you are using an unfamiliar site to make sure it is

- Use strong passwords and NEVER share your passwords or PIN numbers.
- Keep your software and virus protection up to date.

Spoofed Government Websites

Be aware of the website you're on when making online transactions for services. It is known that government websites are commonly spoofed and can become a trap for consumers thinking they are updating their personal/birth records, purchasing a fishing license, changing their address, or renewing a license or other service. Always be sure you're on a secure site by looking for the lock icon in the browser and that "https" is listed in the URL. Also, after clicking links within a secure site, watch your URL to make sure you remain in a secure site and that you are not redirected to a different website.

Be mindful, stay educated and shop safely online!
