TAX TIME FRAUD TIPS

Be aware of the ways scammers can impersonate tax agencies and other people claiming to be involved with your taxes.

PHONE CALLS

Do not trust your caller ID as scammers can fake or spoof caller ID numbers to appear to be from a government agency.

If you are contacted by someone claiming to be from the IRS or a related agency, but you do not owe taxes or have no reason to believe you owe taxes:

- Do not give out any information and hang up immediately.
- You can report the Caller ID and callback number to the IRS by emailing it to phishing@irs.gov, the subject line should include "IRS Phone Scam."

To verify if you owe taxes, you can visit the IRS.gov website and select the Pay tab.

MESSAGES

Government Agencies will not initiate contact with taxpayers through social media platforms, text messaging, emails or by phone.

The IRS along with its authorized collection agencies will never:

- Leave pre-recorded, urgent or threatening messages.
- Threaten to send a police officer to arrest you.
- Demand immediate payment with pre-paid debit or gift cards or wire transfers.
- Demand payment without giving the tax payer time to question the amount due.

OTHER FRAUD TIPS

- Never share your online banking login information (or login information for any websites that you frequent).
- Never allow people who you do not know personally to login/take control of your computer. Reputable companies will not contact you by phone and insist in gaining access to your computer.
- Reputable companies will not ask you to pay a fee to receive a refund for funds they claim you are being charged. They will also not ask you to pay them by gift card or pre-paid debit cards.
