Happy Retirement, Annette!





PHONE SCAMS LETS SPOT THEM AND STOP THEM!

Tax season is prime time for scams to multiply as fraudsters know consumers have more money to spend. Here are a few red flags, examples and a few tips to help prevent future calls.

Scams

Fraudsters sometimes impersonate law Imposter enforcement or other government agencies. Real agencies like this will not call and threaten you and they will not call and ask for personal information! They may also impersonate as a merchant you frequent, family member, love interest or someone stating there is an issue with your computer.

Loan or Scams

Big profit guarantees with an investment or **Investment** quaranteeing loans/credit cards for up-front

Scams

Charity Fraudsters will also pose as charities especially during any disaster relief efforts

Extended Warranties Fraudsters convince you to buy overpriced extended warranties that may be worthless

"FREE" **Trials**

Be careful when signing up for products that are "free" but need your debit/credit card info to process

Prize and Lottery Scams

You WON but you need to pay taxes, registration fees or shipping...it is a scam!
